### 100% COTTON RUGS

Handmade and dyed  
using natural dyes.



Wash separately at  
30 degrees maximum.



Use a gentle cycle  
without bleach.



Avoid continuous exposure to the sun.  
Tumble dry at low temperature.

Sweep the rug with a

gently rub.




2 Apply warm

### WOOL RUGS

Hand tufted with natural  
wool from New Zealand.



For full cleaning we

specialized professionals.



Do not worry if  
fluff appears.

## HOW TO CLEAN



1 Use a vacuum cleaner.



2 Apply cleaning product, vinegar and warm water with a sponge.



3 Clean with a clean cloth and thoroughly dry it.



4 Gently brush the area that was stained.

1 Test the product on a corner to ensure does not discolor.



2 Apply dissolvent with a white cloth.



3 Clean with a clean cloth and thoroughly dry it.



4 Gently brush the area that was stained.



MUD



GENERAL DIRT



1 Gently brush the area that was stained.



2 Apply ammoniac with a wet sponge.



3 Clean with a clean cloth and thoroughly dry it.



4 Gently brush again the area that was stained.
